## CHALLENGE 4

### PROJECT DESIGN: YOUR DREAM GREEN PROM

**For groups; maximum points: 200 plus 50 point bonus**

**YOUR CHALLENGE:** Think outside the limo and the plastic palm tree. **Re-invent your school prom and make it a green event!!** School proms take a huge amount of planning, organization and expense. Why not use all that creative brain power to design a more sustainability-conscious event? Be sure to address food served, clothing, decorations, transportation and any other elements you can think of.

**BONUS:** Come up with a song, skit or dance with your green message, to be performed at the prom. (An alternative would be a song- or skit-based video that you would use to promote the event itself.) Put it on YouTube or send us a copy and we'll give you **an additional 50 points!**

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Plan your dream green prom. You will be submitting your proposal only. Your school will not be judged on whether it was carried out or not (BUT if you actually follow through with the plans, document that as part of the "Environmental Action" Challenge #7)
- Submit your plan in a document not to exceed 5 pages (not including any illustrations or supporting examples).
- Include an explanation of how your plan's components are better for the environment than those of a traditional prom.
- Song, skit or dance should be recorded and uploaded to YouTube (send us the link) or sent to Phipps on CD or thumb drive format. Performance should not exceed 4 minutes.

- **School submits:** Challenge entry form; one project proposal (and optional performance component)
- **Due at Phipps:** Friday, February 8, 5:00 p.m.
